PSI Helps Customers Spend Less by Using Less

Peoria, Ill. (Dec. 3, 2010) – Ameren Illinois recognized Power Supply Industries (PSI) as the ActOnEnergy® “Program Ally of the Year, for the third consecutive year” noting that PSI helped business customers save enough electricity to power more than 1,700 homes per year.

Established in 1983, PSI is a leader in providing compressed air systems and service. The company has locations in Peoria and Decatur as well as St. Louis. During the June 1, 2009 to May 31, 2010 ActOnEnergy program year, PSI submitted 30 projects to ActOnEnergy. These projects resulted in a gross energy savings of more than 18.7 million kilowatt-hours of electricity. In addition, the business customers collected nearly \$750,000 in ActOnEnergy incentives for those 30 projects. “This is the second consecutive year PSI has received Program Ally of the Year honors,” said Cheryl Miller, ActOnEnergy business program manager. “Over the course of those three years, PSI has helped Ameren Illinois business customers save nearly \$3 million in energy costs.”

Since ActOnEnergy was launched in 2008, the amount of annual incentive dollars available to customers has grown from \$3 million to \$10.5 million. The energy efficiency program is funded through a small charge (Rider EDR for electricity customers and Rider GER for natural gas customer) on customer bills. These charges are mandated by state law.
